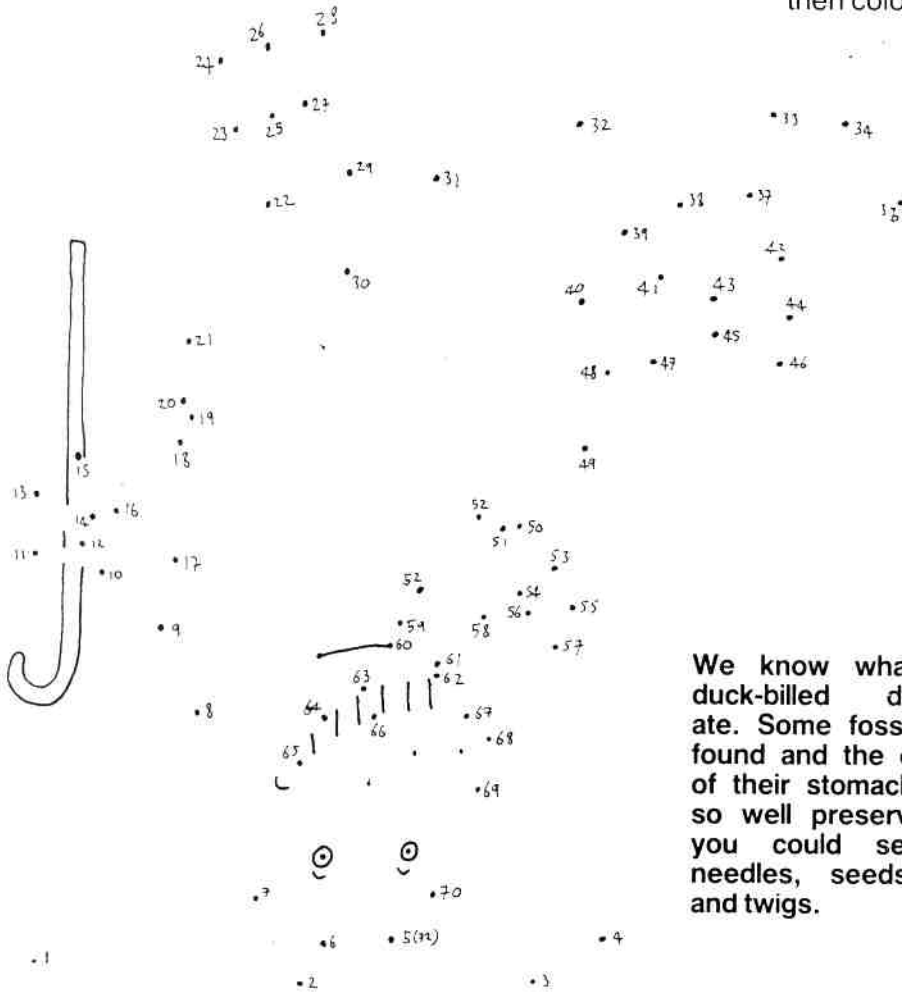


## DOTTY DINOSAUR

In 1877, miners in Bernissart, Belgium, found they were tunnelling through a mass of huge skeletons. They were 300 metres below ground – and the bones were Iguanodon skeletons!

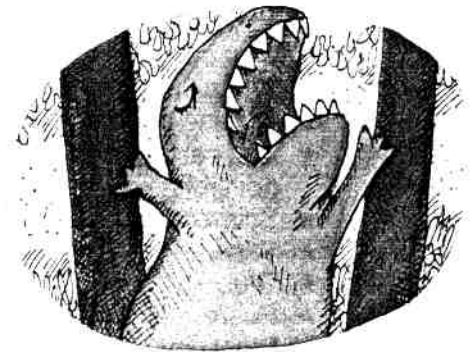
